4. Accompany the gymnasts to GNI and GI squad training sessions when required which will involve travel throughout Ireland.
5. To assist with recommending and writing programmes for all squad gymnasts.
6. To comply with safe working practices laid down by FIG and the Northern Ireland Health and Safety Act.
