KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Coaching	To coach children creating a fun, positive and energetic environment while following the playball method of coaching; ensuring each child reaches the desired level of the program.
Communicating	To be comfortable communicating with parents and children at both levels ensuring maximum customer service at all times.
Working as part of a team	Work as part of a team both alongside and shadowing other playball coaches
Time Management	The candidate must show excellent time management skills in relation to both management of time during lessons and punctuality

Planning and organising lesson plans	While Playball lesson plans are provided, coaches are required to plan and organise themselves and their lesson plans accordingly. Preparation is key.
Learning	The playball method of coaching is unique to playball, and is revised annually, as a result the ideal candidate must be able to develop within the role and the program itself. There are 2 workshops held per year in September and April which coaches must attend, in addition to any additional training required by the franchise.

Qualification	Full playball training is given and as a result no formal qualifications are required, however previous education or experience is desirable to provide a proven track record of performance in a learning environment.
Technology	Word and excel skills are advantageous, but basic computer IT skills are essential, together with use and access to a smart phone.

Essential Criteria:

The ideal candidate must be **patient, tolerant, energetic, enthusiastic, professional** and have a **mature outlook, be responsible, reliable and committed** to the program. A **caring** nature is essential, as is the ability **to have fun**. This is a very rewarding job for the right individual.

Commitment – it is necessary that the ideal candidate can display an understanding of the commitment required due to the nature of working with young children and the progressive nature of the program. Consistency in key to this age group. The ability to commit to both the learning process and the classes themselves is paramount. A love of working with children is essential.

Driving – the Ideal candidate must have a full driving license and access to, or own a car as travel to classes/parties/events/camps is required with the necessary playball equipment.

Police Vetting – Full police vetting will be required and provided to the ideal candidate

Desirable Criteria:

Preference will be given to applicants with **coaching experience** and an **interest in sport**.

A **proven track record** of working with and **mentoring younger children in a result orientated environment** such as a school or classroom or learning environment would also be desirable.
