## **Communication Arrangements**

The Senior First Aid Officer / Medical operative will be issued with a short wave radio, briefed on its operation, advised of the appropriate channel and informed that the Safety Officer should be advised as soon as practicable of any incidents.

Additional radios will be provided as appropriate. At a specified event that requires a doctor to be present, a radio will be issued to the doctor.

A representative of the First Aid / Medical provider or a NIAS Officer will be invited to be present in the Control Room during specified activities to facilitate a multi agency approach in the event of an incident.

The Senior First Aid Officer / Medical operative will be requested to provide a written report to the Safety Officer of any injuries / incidents at the close of the specified activity.

The First Aid Officer / Medical operative will be invited to meet with the Safety Officer periodically to discuss medical first aid provision and related issues at the Sports Ground.
