

Use of School Sports Facilities by Outside Groups

Presentation of draft headline findings

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RATIONALE

 Sport Matters includes a target and key step associated with extra curricular sporting opportunities for children:

PA6: By 2014 to provide every child in NI over the age of 8 years with the opportunity to participate in at least two hours per week of extracurricular sport and physical recreation

In consultation with children and young people, provide the opportunity for every child to access two hours extra-curricular sport and physical recreation per week through initiatives such as Extended Schools, Active Schools and community sport programmes



BACKGROUND

- Sport Matters includes targets related to physical education and extra curricular sporting opportunities for children (PA3 and PA6)
- Information gap in relation to PA6 and extra curricular sporting opportunities
- Participation SMIG Chair tasked SNI with undertaking a research project to determine current levels of opportunities offered in NI schools.



BACKGROUND

Overall aim of the research:

- To establish a baseline (time spent per week) relating to extra curricular sporting opportunities within NI schools.
- To establish an indication of the proportion of schools that make their sports facilities available for use by outside groups.



METHODOLOGY

- All 1,111 schools in NI surveyed (primary, postprimary and special schools).
- Relevant information sourced from the DE.
- Schools email with a link to an online survey and also issued with a postal survey.
- Responses were received from 496 schools (45% response rate).
- Wording of questions consistent with previous research (c. 2007) for comparative purposes.



Sport Northern Ireland Primary School PE and Extra Curricular Sport Survey

Aim: To establish a baseline (time spent per week) relating to extra curricular sporting opportunities within the Primary School sector.

For the purposes of this survey "extra curricular sport" is defined as sport and other forms of physical activity within a school setting or organised by the school (excluding curricular PE) outside normal school hours.



OVERALL RESPONSES


 Are your sports facilities available for use by outside groups during the evenings, weekends or school holidays?


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
OVERALL RESPONSES (BY SCHOOL TYPE)

 On average, how many hours per week are your sports facilities used by outside groups?




54% of schools' sports facilities are used for 5 hours or less per week

 On average, how many days per week are your sports facilities used by outside groups?




60% of schools' sports facilities are used for 3 days or less per week

 On average, how many outside groups use your sports facilities per week?




72% of schools' sports facilities are used (on average) by 5 groups or less

 What are the perceived barriers to making your sports facilities available for use by outside groups?



80% of post primary schools would consider it in the future.
