- Language access: need for translation/interpretation in rural GP practices and public meetings.
- **Cultural outreach**: trusted champions or mobile hubs are needed to facilitate engagement.
- Service access: transport or remote delivery to overcome distance.
- **Economic support**: tailored job training and employment advice for minority rural workers.
- Community linkage: promoting multicultural events to integrate and reduce isolation.
